Trinity Lutheran Church Annual Meeting January 24, 2016

Call to Order

The Annual meeting of Trinity Lutheran Church was held following the church service on January 24, 2016 with a quorum present. Chair-person Chris Woerner called the meeting to order and Pastor Koos led in devotions.

Annual Meeting Minutes and Pastor's report

The minutes of the previous Annual Meeting, the Semi-Annual Meeting, and the Special October meeting were presented. There was a motion by Dean Thernes and a second by Michael Holtmeier to approve with one correction to the October Meeting. The motion carried. The Annual Pastor's report was presented by Pastor Koos. See included.

Presentation of Ballots

The ballots were presented. There was a motion by Tim Garrison and a second by Larry Wattjes to accept the ballots. Ballots were marked and collected for counting.

Presentation of Reports

Reports presented consisted of the Pastor's report, Chairperson's report. Treasurer's report, Memorial report, Investment report, and WELCA report. There was a motion by Duane Wollenburg and a second by Tom Koch to accept the reports. The motion carried.

Old Business

The first item of Old Business included discussion of the installation of handicapped pews to be installed by Radigan Schloter in the near future. There was also discussion of the option to have the pews reupholstered. Thrivent has offered to finance the handicapped pews.

The next item of Old Business was discussion of the Constitution update. Mr. Biggs from the synod has approved the updated constitution. There was a motion by Tim Garrison and a second by Adam Wollenburg to accept the most recent update of the constitution. The motion carried. Following congregational approve, the updated constitution will go to a synod meeting in April for approval. The constitution will go into effect following synod approval.

Flood damage updates were discussed to include information that insurance has covered most of the damages. The parsonage roof is scheduled for repair when weather permits and upgrades to the parsonage basement will be covered in New Business.

New Business

The first item of new business included discussion of updates to the parsonage basement related to flood damage as well as age. Vice -chair Brian Nelson presented some options to include new windows, an egressed window, shelving and enclosing a bedroom and bathroom. He estimated the cost to be approximately \$30,000. There was discussion of using some funds from the Memorial Fund to support this project. Support for this funding plan was supported by Tim Garrison and Sharon Rehm. No dissenting opinions were presented.

The second item of new business was presentation of the 2016 Budget. Some new categories were added to the budget to eliminate an excessive amount of items entered under miscellaneous. Upon review of the budget it was discovered that an additional \$6,000 was required to cover the pastor pension bringing the budget total to \$151,015.00. There was a motion by Dean Thernes and a second by Darin Mahloch to approve the budget as amended. The motion carried.

The third item presented was the opportunity to opt out of receiving the Newsletter by mail when it is possible to access that item electronic. Members will continue to receive the paper copy unless they sign up to receive it electronically.

Chris Woerner noted that the 50^{th} Anniversary of the Church Dedication will be July 10, 2015. Members have the opportunity to sign up for the committee to plan that celebration.

Results of the voting were disclosed as follows: Vic Chairman is Duane Wollenburg, Council Members are Jesse Gronemeyer, Delva Smith, and Joel Kaelin, Assistant Sunday School Superintendent is Jana Muehling, Auditing Committee is Cindy Wollenburg, Nominating Committee are Karen Rahe and Fred Koch, Nebraska Synod Assembly Delegate is Liz Poessnecker. There was a motion by Mike Holtmeier and a second by Verdell Koch to destroy the ballots. The motion carried. Installation of these offices will be conducted at the next Sunday service.

Other new business included an offer by Thrivent advocates to use choice dollars toward the purchase of a lawn mower for use at the parsonage.

There was a motion by Adam Wollenburg and a second by Mike Holtmeier to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried.

The meeting was concluded with Pastor Koos leading the group in recitation of the Lord's Prayer.

Trinity Lutheran Church Semi-Annual Meeting July 26, 2015

Call to Order

The Semi-Annual meeting was held following the church service on July 26, 2015 Chair-person Chris Woerner called the meeting to order and Pastor Koos led in devotions.

Annual Meeting Minutes and Pastor's report

The minutes of the Annual Meeting were presented. There was a motion by Darin Mahloch and a second by Tim Garrison to approve the minutes as presented. The motion carried. The Semi-Annual Pastor's report was presented by Pastor Koos. See included.

Old Business

The first item of Old Business included discussion regarding the newly installed Video Screen which was purchased with donations.

The second item concerned the update on the church pews. Paul Radigan of Radigan Shottler indicated that refinishing the pews was not a practical option because of the veneer finish. He did provide an estimate of \$400 to \$500 for each handicapped seat. There was a suggestion by Joyce Holtmeier to consider reupolstery of the pews. Church pews will continue to remain on the Five Year Plan.

New Business

The first item of new business included an update on flood repairs. There were no serious damages to the church. The parsonage did have water in the basement. At the current time there is no longer seepage in the basement. A sealant will be applied to reduce the risk of further seepage. Currently approximately \$7,750 of the approximate \$10,000 insurance payment has been used for major purchases with some continued work to be done in the parsonage.

The second item of new business addressed the constitutional update process. Pastor Koos's mentor Rev Timothy Bernard has assisted in terms of providing input in regard to changes to comply with the requirements of the model constitution. The goal is to have constitutional updates to present to the congregation in September or October.

Use of the Suggestion Box was discussed. Input through the Suggestion Box is valuable. A reminder that all items must be signed to be considered by the council.

The social committee will be meeting to plan fall events and reported \$350 raised for the Back Pack program by the golf outing.

There was a motion by Duane Wollenburg and a second by Mike Holtmeier to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried.

The meeting was concluded with Pastor Koos leading the group in recitation of the Lord's Prayer.

Looking back over the last year, it was a good year for our congregation, especially considering we didn't have to wade through any more flooding or hail storms. We confirmed a large group of 12 students and started a smaller class of 6 students in the fall. We celebrated our 50th anniversary of the church building being re-built after a catastrophic fire. We shifted our bible study to a new day/time and there has been increased participation. We started up a new men's bible study group in the fall that has had strong participation. Our Sunday school classes continue to grow with the help of our eager and organized teachers. Both our praise and adult choirs bless our worship services with joyful song. It was a special treat having our brass band play for us during the Advent season. I hope to have them come back every Advent season from now on! Hearing them on Easter morning just isn't enough. Our Sunday school kids and adult choir made the Christmas season truly festive with their program and cantata.

There are few ministries I'd like to see improve over the next year. Our monthly adult bible study on Christian transformation hasn't been quite as well received as our prior study on parenting. Perhaps we might need to find a different topic. Also, participation in our committees has been lacking, in particular our Social Committee. We want to plan events that will engage our members so we need a variety of perspectives with fresh ideas to meet this goal. Please consider being a part of the Social Committee. Finally, our financial giving has become somewhat irregular. Hopefully the introduction of an "e-giving" option might reclaim some regularity for those of us with trouble attending weekly services. It could even help those who attend services regularly! Yes, financial giving is a ministry, an essential ministry to help all other ministries here at Trinity. Please consider your giving for the year ahead and not only maintaining your current giving but actually growing it. I know each year my family and I add to our giving and our joy from doing that grows considerably.

After taking 6 months off from home visitations, I'm going to get back out there in the year ahead. I just don't see enough of you on a regular basis and I do so enjoy connecting with you more than Sunday mornings allow for. I'm not going to make up a schedule but will just randomly reach out to you throughout the year. Hopefully this flexibility will offer more chances to connect. All in all, I'm excited for our shared ministry in the year ahead. I'd like to be a part of more than 4 baptisms, less than 3 funerals, more than 6 new members, and more than 2 weddings like last year. We have one wedding scheduled for April but otherwise the expected ministry is a blank sheet. Wherever the year leads us, be assured that I will be praying for each of you and hoping for another strong year of rich ministry.
